Ten month fellowships for U.S. educators in the field of Teaching English to Speakers of Other Languages (TESOL)

Generally have two or three in the Philippines at any time

Short-term, specially designed assignments abroad for U.S. academics in the fields of Teaching English as a Foreign Language (TEFL), Teaching English as a Second Language (TESL), and Applied Linguistics
